RULES

- 1. Club equipment must not be taken from the premises under any circumstances unless **authorised** specifically by the President.
- 2. If you use Club equipment during the evening then return it to the appropriate locker or bag at the end of the evening.
- 3. All marked Club fencing jackets must be hung up on the hangers provided in the appropriate locker when you have finished using them.
- 4. All fencers will sign the register at Reception **ON FIRST ARRIVAL** to the Sports Hall.
- 5. No outside shoes may be worn in the Sports Hall.
- 6. Only trainers that have non-marking soles may be worn in the Sports Hall.
- 7. All Club business should be conducted on arrival at Reception. (The Reception desk is manned between 8pm and 10pm).
- 8. The Swindon Fencing Club Committee recommends that all members of the Swindon Fencing Club be individual members of the British Fencing Association (BFA). Details on how to join the BFA can be obtained from Reception or found in the Swindon Fencing Club Membership Pack.
- 9. All fencers will stop fencing at 9.55pm to allow sufficient time to put the equipment away. The caretaker is waiting to lock the hall shortly after 10pm.
- 10. A decision made by the Committee is final. In the event of a split Committee, the President's decision is final.

REMINDERS

- Please take the bags containing electrical equipment to the piste and repack the equipment in the same bag when you have finished fencing at the end of the evening.
- It is the responsibility of the last two fencers using a box to put it away in its bag and into the Club's storage lockers.
- Check that the boxes are switched to "foil" and are turned off before they are put away.
- Any faulty Club equipment should be reported to Armourer (Mike).
